    - 111 out of 255 cameras have been deployed as of 2/1
  - Citywide Executive Anti-Racist Transformation Discussions
    - Third (1/29) and fourth discussions (2/4) about Anti-Racist transformation strategic direction
- Section 3: Current State Analysis of TPD
  - 21CP provided [64 preliminary recommendations](#) 1/29

    - Final report with substantial discussion of analyzed data, rationale for recommendations, and examples of best/promising practices by 3/15

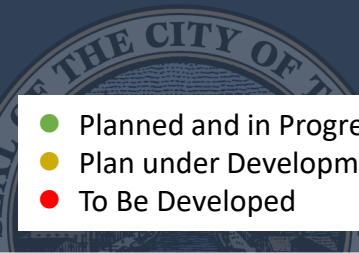

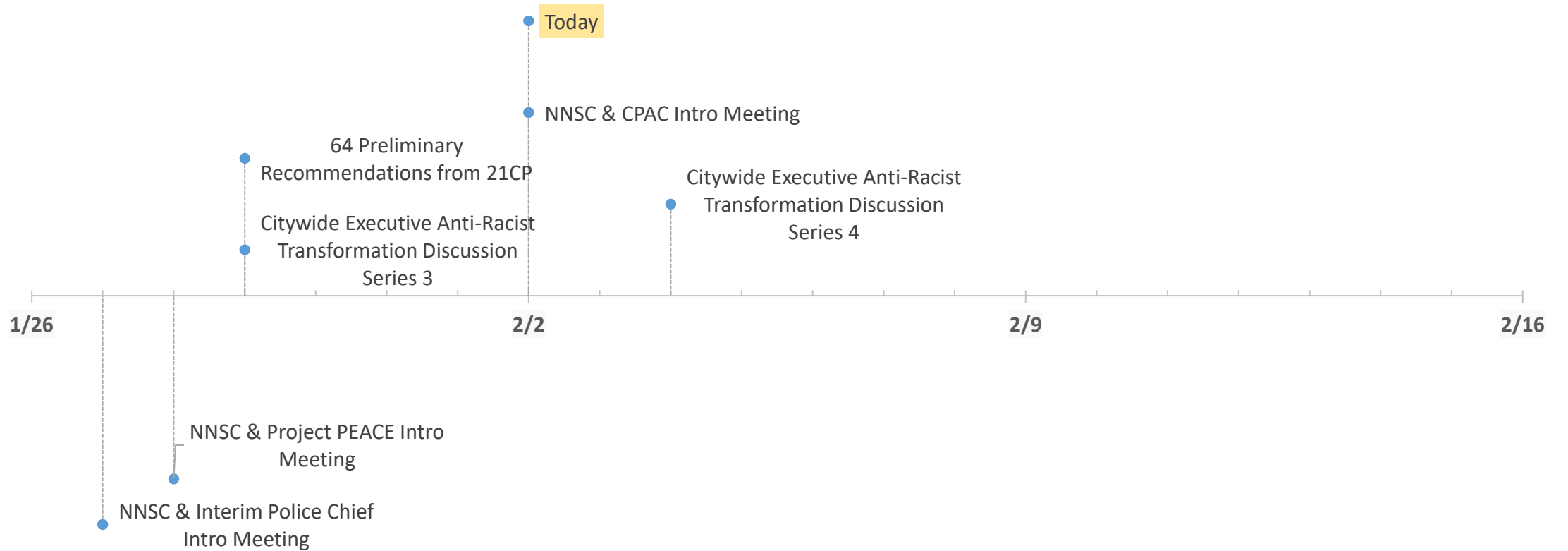
