 - #3 Alternatives Evaluation Report



Hybrid Alternative 4




Grant Status/TODAG Input

PSRC \$2.1 Million Design Grant

- Design work could start in July 2021
- Total project cost as designed \$25-\$26 Million
 - Evaluating Cost Saving Options
 - Concrete road to only concrete intersections and bus stops
 - Do not replace sidewalk/curb/gutter in good condition
 - Etc. (more to follow in October meeting)

October TODAG Meeting

- Updated Design to be Presented
- Input Requested:
 - Parking Layout Parking added on north side from C to G Streets
 - Overall Roadway Design
 - Inclusion of Transit/HOV Lane
 - » Removal from grant Viewed as "Significant" Change by PSRC
