FOLLOW-UP ORDER ON CONDITIONS IMPOSED

THIS MATTER concerns a Potentially Dangerous Dog Notice issued to Appellant regarding Appellant's neutered, male Labrador Retriever/Border Collie mix, Xavier. The appeal came on for hearing before JEFF H. CAPELL, the Hearing Examiner for the City of Tacoma, Washington, originally on May 24, 2018. Both parties were represented by counsel. On the way to the hearing, the parties had reached an agreed stipulation that disposed of most of the issues that otherwise would have needed resolving through the hearing/decision-issuance process.

Arguments were presented on the remaining issues without testimony being taken.

Thereafter, the Examiner issued his Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Order on June 1, 2018 (the "Order"). The Order contained the following requirements/conditions and timeline:

1. Xavier's designation as a Potentially Dangerous Dog shall remain in effect from May 24, 2018, until midnight on May 24, 2019.

- All attendant conditions and restrictions, as agreed to by the parties in the 2. Stipulation, shall be in effect for that same twelve (12) month period, except that Xavier need not be muzzled when outdoors while on Appellant's premises if he is under the personal supervision of a family member fifteen (15) years of age or above. For purposes of this condition, "personal supervision" means that a qualifying family member is present outdoors in sight and hearing distance of Xavier.
- 3. If all the conditions and restrictions agreed to by the parties in the Stipulation—as modified herein—are complied with for the twelve (12) month period specified at 1. above, Xavier's designation as a Potentially Dangerous Dog and all attendant restrictions/conditions shall be rescinded as of May 25, 2019.

The time frame set forth in paragraph 3 immediately above has now expired.

On June 3, 2019, City of Tacoma Animal Control, Control and Compliance Supervisor Joseph Satter-Hunt telephoned the Office of the Hearing Examiner, and informed staff that Animal Control considers all conditions set forth in the Order to be met, and that there have been no new incidents involving Xavier.

As a result, it is **HEREBY ORDERED** that the above conditions 1 through 3, first imposed in the Order, are lifted and the designation of Xavier as a Potentially Dangerous Dog, is rescinded.
