21 applicable taxes, plus a 10 percent contingency, for a cumulative total of  
22 \$557,445.90, budgeted from the Solid Waste Fund, for a standby generator,  
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switchgear and automatic transfer switch to be used in the event of a power failure to operate the solid waste compactors in the Solid Waste Main Receiving Building pursuant to Contract No. CW2257282, consistent with Exhibit "A."
