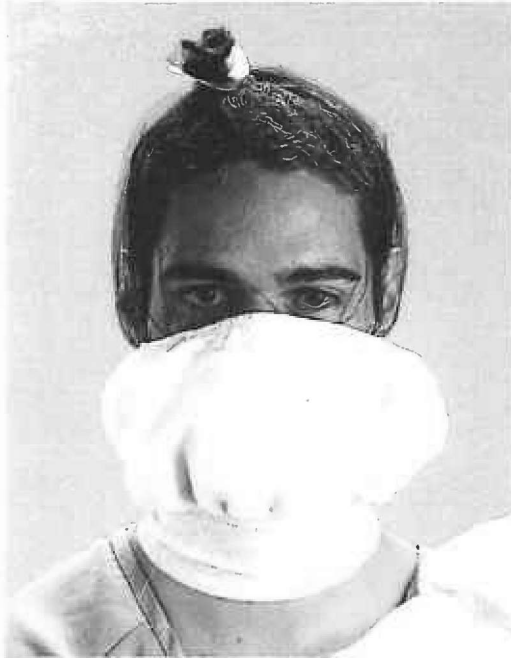

TRANZPORT HOOD

IMPORTANT PRODUCT INFORMATION—PLEASE READ BEFORE USING



INTENDED USE: To reduce the risk of the wearer transmitting fluids (saliva and mucous) from the facial area by spitting, sneezing or coughing. Improper use can result in serious injury or death. **WARNING:** Improper use may cause asphyxiation, suffocation or drowning in one's own fluids.



INSTRUCTIONS: Open bag and remove Hood. Place hood over the head of the person so the mesh fabric is covering the eye area (top) of the head, and the filtration fabric is covering the lower half of the head (below nostrils).

For the best fit, the center elastic will go under the nose and over the ears. For better protection, the elastic may be placed above the nostrils.

Carefully push the white plastic Secure-Lock tab down toward the top of the head while holding the top of the mesh fabric. This should take the slack out of the top and help secure the Hood in position. **DO NOT** push so tightly as to be uncomfortable or impair vision of the wearer.

CONDITIONS FOR USE:

- Wearer must be under control and restrained.
- Wearer must be under constant visual supervision and should NOT be left unattended.
- **DO NOT USE** on anyone that is vomiting, having difficulty breathing, or is bleeding profusely from the mouth or nose area.
- Remove all jewelry and eyewear before application.
- The Hood is one size fits all. If there is difficulty applying due to a large size head, discontinue use.

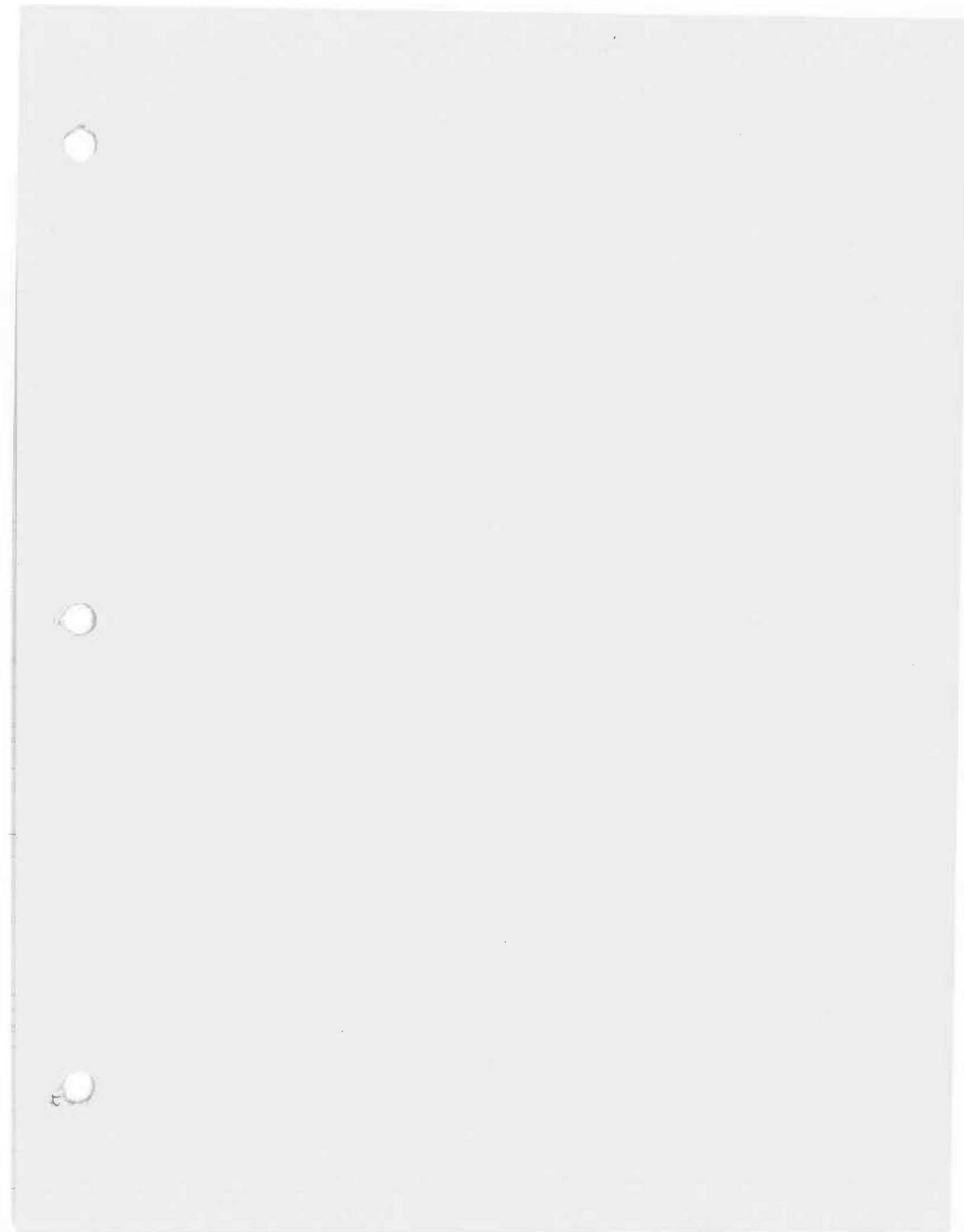

On July 20, 2021 I contacted the Tacoma Police Department's current Quartermaster officer, Officer Zachary Cain and requested he check the Quartermaster area for any of the spit hoods that were being used by the Department when the Ellis incident occurred.

Officer Cain provided a spit hood that was still in its packaging.

The packaging consists of a sealed plastic sleeve with a paper sleeve inside to keep the spit hood compressed within the packaging.

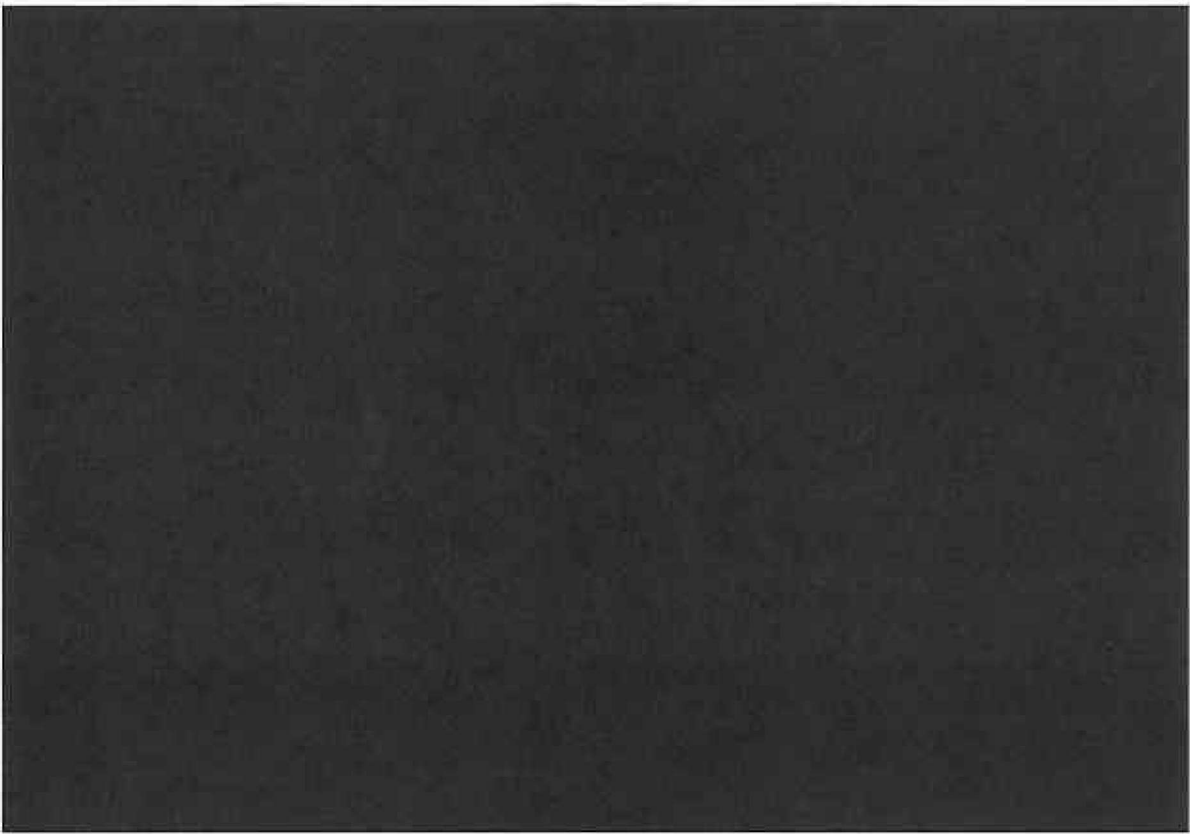
The paper sleeve contains the following conditions printed on it;

CONDITIONS FOR USE:

- DO NOT USE this product unless prisoner is under control and restrained
- Wearer must be under constant visual supervision and should NEVER be left unattended
- DO NOT USE on anyone that is vomiting, having difficulty breathing, or is bleeding profusely from the area around the mouth or nose
- Remove prisoner's jewelry and eyewear before application
- If there is difficulty applying due to a large size head, discontinue use

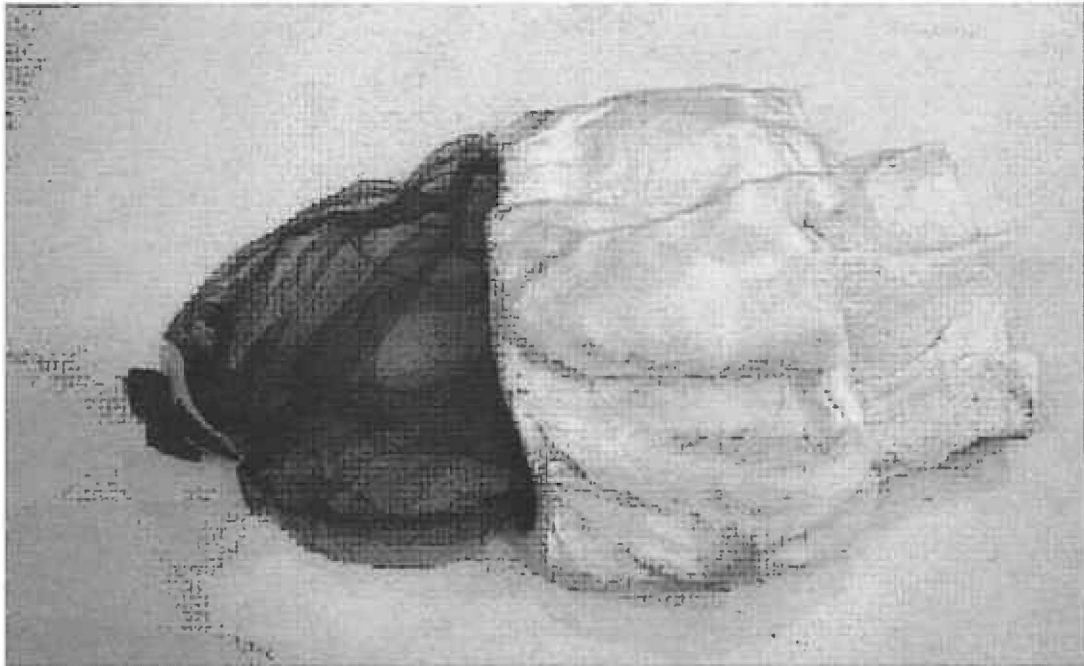

Yes, it is the same mask, but unfortunately we don't have any of the orange version available. The orange version was just a short term material swap, same material just a different color, then we reverted back to the white.

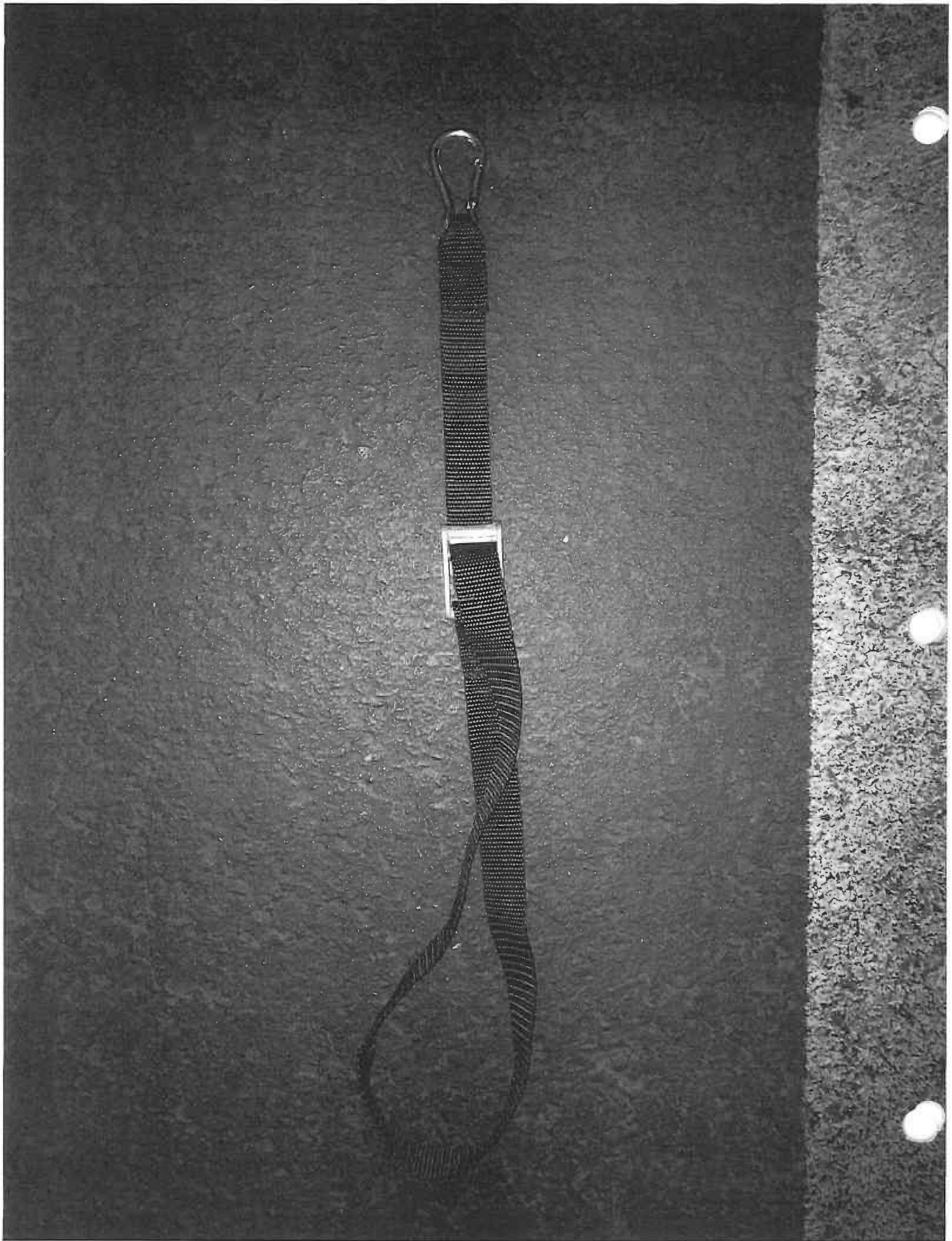

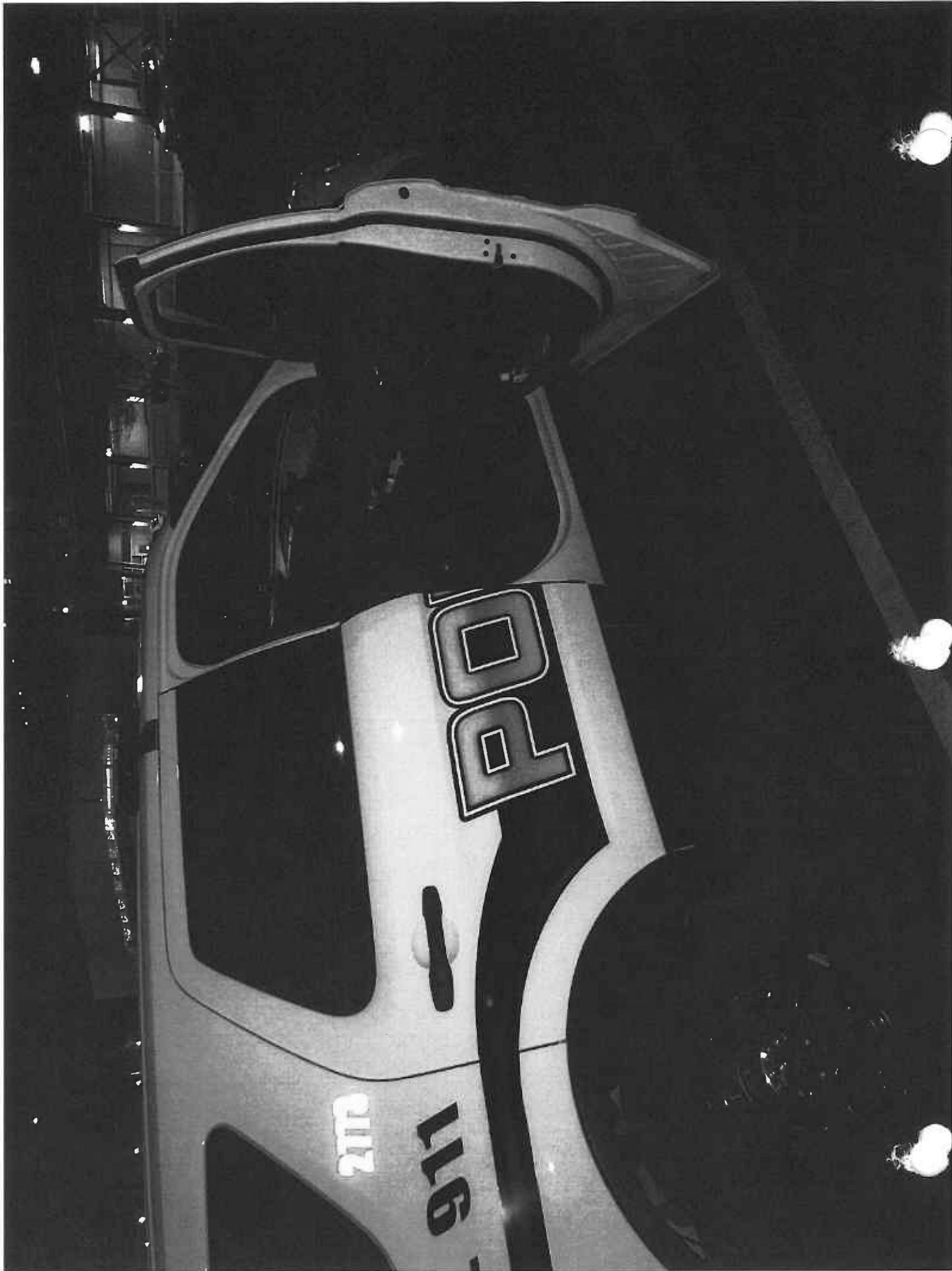

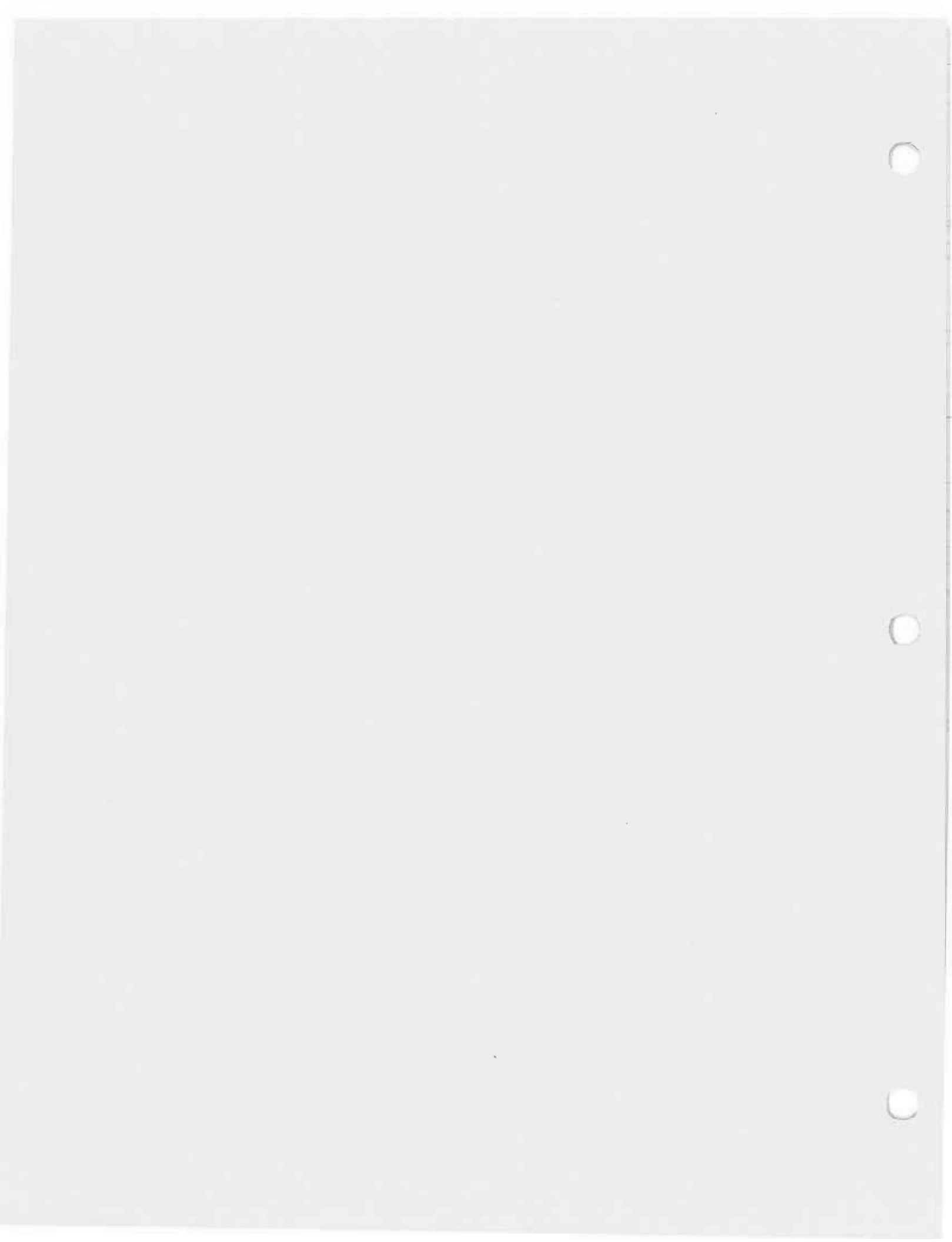
