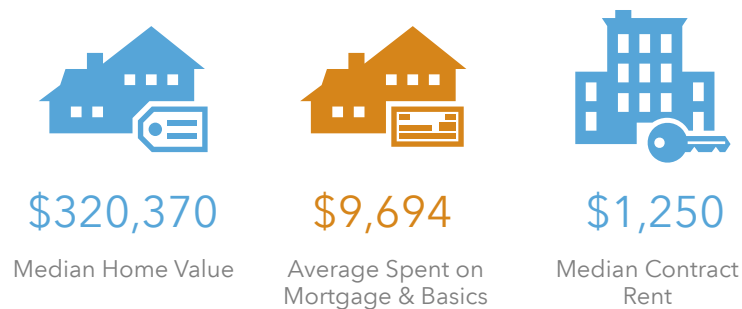

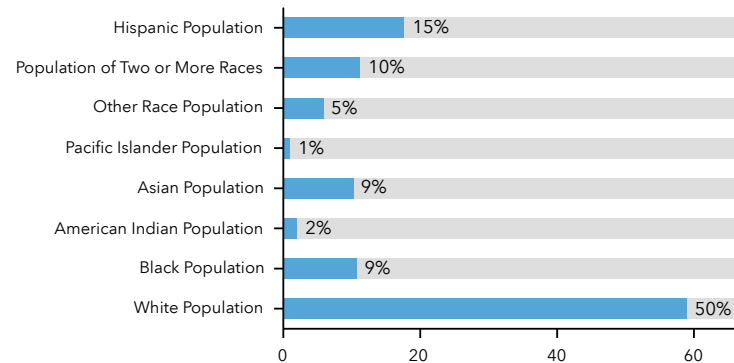

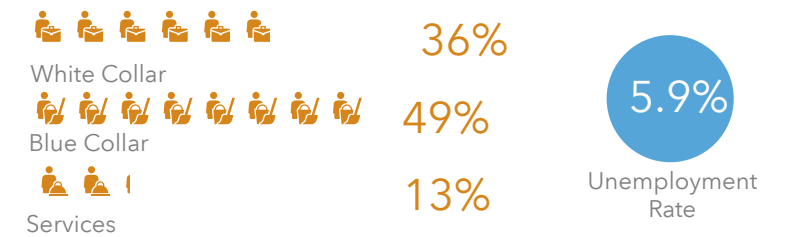

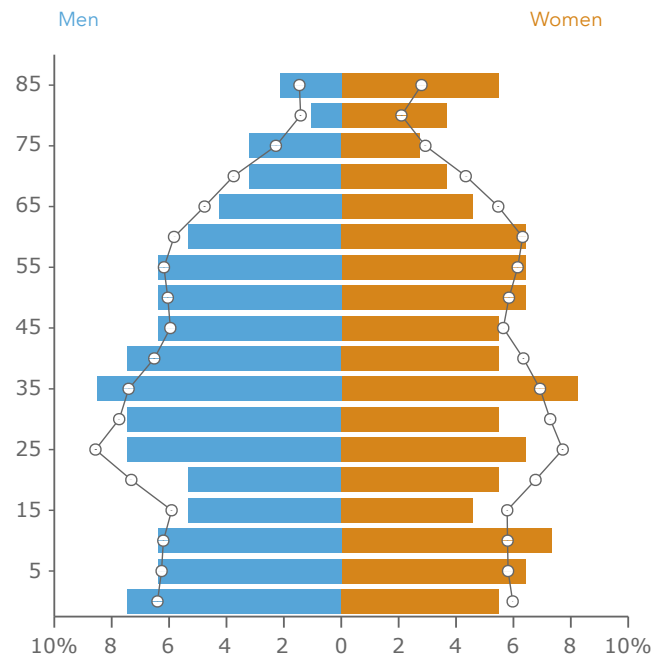
2021 Race and Hispanic Origin (Esri)

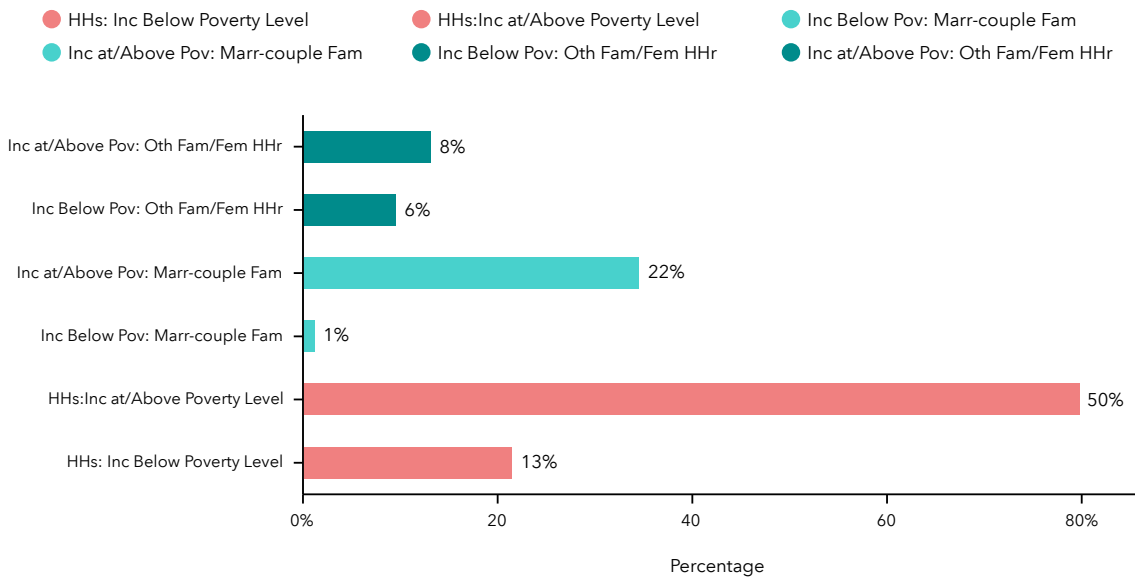

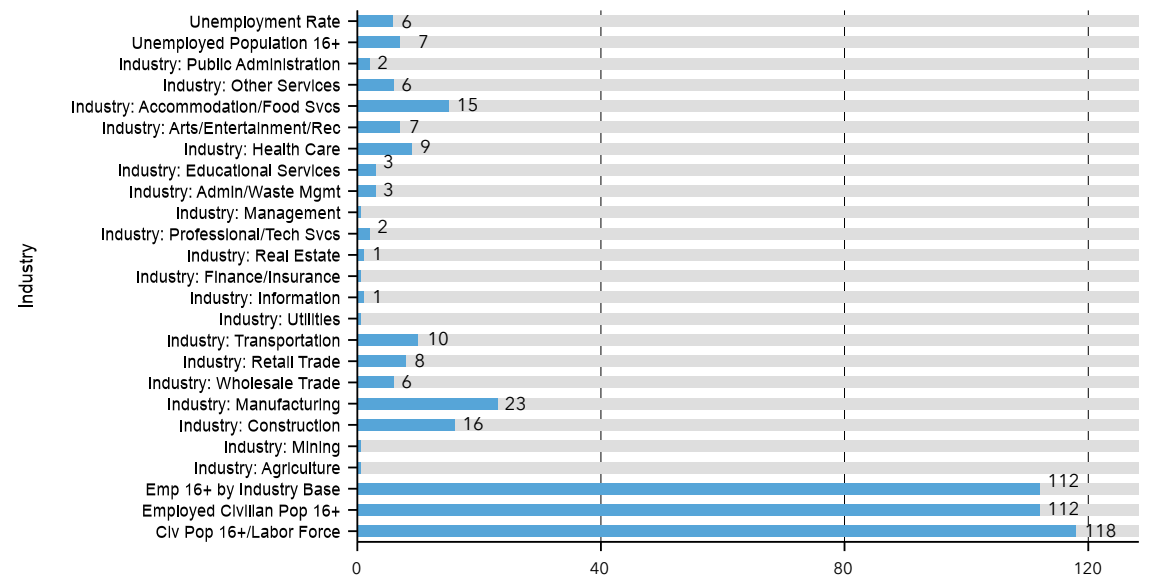
