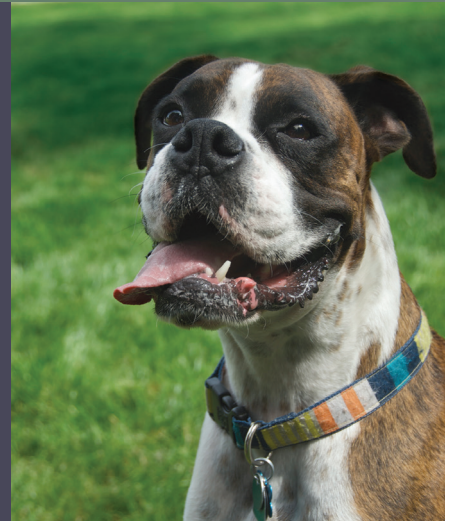


Neighborhood Dog Waste Station Program



Is dog poop a problem in your neighborhood?

Obtain a FREE dog waste station to make clean-up easy for dog owners.



How can I obtain a free dog waste station for my neighborhood?

You should:

- Live within the City of Tacoma.
- Identify a location in a neighborhood common area where there is a dog waste problem
- Identify a "sponsor" in your neighborhood who is next to the location you identified and who will:
 - 1) Provide replacement bags*
 - 2) Report the number of dog bags used at the end of each year
 - 3) Monitor station use and condition
- Stations can only be installed in areas with permission from the property owner

Dog waste station sponsors will receive:

- A dog waste bag dispenser with sign installed by the City
- Two rolls of dog waste bags per station (after these bags are used, the sponsor will provide additional replacement bags).*



Scoop the poop, bag it, and put it in the trash.

*Free replacement rolls of dog waste bags are available to pick up from the EnviroHouse at 3510 S. Mullen, Tacoma, 98409 WA (at former landfill).

Dog waste stations and bag rolls are available while supplies last.
