
Neighborhood Council Review: Engagement Survey Results

Open July 18, 2024 through September 3, 2024 | Received 148 Responses

82% of surveys were from community members, **11%** were from Neighborhood Council Members, **3%** were from partner agency liaisons, and **3%** were from City of Tacoma liaisons.

Demographic Data




- Compared to the <u>Tacoma Equity Index</u>, our race and ethnicity categories showed no more than a 2% difference in all categories except for a 5% difference in the "Latino/Latina/Latinx/ Hispanic" category.
- We reached folks from 16–18-year-old, through the 75+ age range, with most respondents being between 35-64.
- 82% of individuals identified as cisgendered with most folks (51%) identifying as female, and 5% identifying as non-binary or prefer to self-describe.
- 11% identified as LGBTQIA+ and 71% identified as Heterosexual.

- Of the respondents who have heard of the NC Program, 27% are involved with their NC:
 - 22% Attended NC Meetings
 - o 13% on the newsletter distribution list
 - 20% Attended/supported NC sponsored events
 - 3% Other (participation on NC, communicating with NC members)

- 32% Focus outreach to underrepresented communities in NCs
- **26%** Send out/update webpage with meeting reminders & agendas in advance of the NC Meetings
- 24% Adjust meeting topics to better align with community input/feedback/needs
- 24% Improve/update/create volunteer sign up platforms for various volunteer opportunities

- 22% Promote culturally relevant events throughout my NC
- 20% Create a more welcoming & inclusive atmosphere where everyone feels valued, heard & included
- 15% Remove barriers to increase access (i.e., transportation, internet, mobility, language, etc.)
- 14% Change meeting times/locations/platforms
- 13% Increase educational & professional development opportunities for personal growth
- 9% Other
- 7% Meetings feel too structured & should be adjusted
- **3%** Meetings do not have enough structure & should be adjusted

Survey Themes: Standards & Guidelines/TMC 1.45 Feedback

- **10%** of survey respondents believe there should be changes to Tacoma Municipal Code (TMC) 1.45—**13 comments** related to TMC 1.45 changes, the main themes being:
 - · Reword/rework/clarify/align with Standards and Guidelines
 - Neighborhood Councils become advisors to the City
 - Changing the structure of the Neighborhood Councils
 - Examining/updating Neighborhood Council boundaries
 - Re-establishing the Innovative Grants Program
- 28% of survey respondents believe that there should be changes to the Standards and Guidelines
 document—35 individuals provided comments and recommendations to at least one section of the
 Standards and Guidelines.
