2023 Disparity Study Recommendations

The City of Tacoma recently conducted a disparity study which looked at the city's contracting data over a 5-year period from 2017 to 2022. The study was completed in October 2023 and the final report will be posted on the City website. The study included internal and external stakeholder group meetings, with members of the EIC Advisory Committee invited to attend. The WA Minority Business Development Agency Business Center was present to learn more and support the EIC Program efforts to improve access to contracts.

The Disparity Study recommendations are:

- 1. Refine overall aspirational MBE/WBE Goal
- 2. Continue contract goals and expand to professional services
- 3. Implement SBE Evaluation and price preferences
- 4. Further develop a small contract program
- 5. Perform additional outreach and relationship building
- 6. Participate in MBE/WBE/SBE Capacity building
- 7. Consider other steps to encourage small business utilization
- 8. Allocate sufficient resources for program success

EIC Staff plans on unbundling Public Works contracts, including the Links to Opportunities project and the Streets Initiative projects. EIC Staff also have plans for outreach and relationship building, including creating a video library for training purposes. The team is considering requests from businesses for training on topics such as bonding, estimating, accounting, marketing, digital literacy, legal matters, and labor compliance. EIC Staff would like to reach more diverse demographic populations in our outreach efforts.

As EIC Advisory members review the recommendations, please reach out with feedback.

EIC Staff's Intentions are to be transparent and accountable to stakeholders as we move and review the recommendations provided by the Disparity Study.

Every 5 years, the city is required to review the program through a disparity study.

Every year, EIC Staff is required to provide a yearly report on program performance.
