Attachment 1

The following section 4.1 of the agreement is modified as follows:

4.1 <u>Transfer of Service Area.</u> Upon the first day of the month of the first odd month following the Annexation Date (the "Transfer Date"), the stormwater service area that is coextensive with the PAA (Transferred Service Area) shall transfer to the City. <u>Effective April 1, 2024, the stormwater service area that is coextensive with the PAA (Transferred Service Area) shall transfer to the City.</u> All stormwater service customers within the Transferred Service Area shall, upon the Transfer Date, become customers of the City of Tacoma stormwater utility and the County will cease billing customers within the Transferred Service Area for stormwater services received or other provided by the City on or after the Transfer Date.
