 - Phase 1: March 31 service change
 - Route 13 replaced by Ruston Runner
- **Runner**
 - Micro On-Demand Transit
 - ADA accessible
 - Dial-a-ride or order through app
- **Proctor Farmers Market**
 - September 7 & October 26
