Arrest Made in Homicide Investigation – 1800 block of South 15th Street

At approximately 8:20 p.m. on March 23, 2024, our officers responded to the 1800 block of South 15th Street regarding a possible shooting. Upon arrival, they learned a juvenile female was transported to a local hospital by private vehicle suffering from a gunshot wound. The victim succumbed to her injury at the hospital.

Initially, the victim was described being fifteen years of age. As the investigation progressed, it was learned the victim had just turned seventeen-years old.

Detectives and Crime Scene personnel have responded to the area. This incident was investigated as a homicide.

Detectives investigating the case developed probable cause for a suspect in the homicide. On March 26, 2024, the adult male suspect surrendered himself. He was booked into Pierce County Jail for the charge of Murder in the First Degree.
