Homicide Arrest

Tacoma, Wash. – On January 6, at 3:32 a.m., South Sound 911 received a report of a body wrapped in a tarp in the 200 block of E. 23rd St. Responding Tacoma Fire Department personnel located a deceased male and requested Tacoma Police.

The Pierce County Medical Examiner's Office identified the victim as 30-year-old Jeremy Tomlinson. The manner of death was ruled homicide.

Through their investigation, detectives identified a suspect and developed probable cause for his arrest.

Today, officers arrested the 30-year-old male suspect in Tacoma for the murder of Jeremy Tomlinson. The suspect was booked into jail for Murder 2^{nd} Degree.
