Night of 1,000 Stars DUI Emphasis Tonight in Tacoma

Tacoma, Wash. – Tonight, the Tacoma Police Department will be hosting Target Zero's Annual Night of 1,000 Stars DUI Emphasis in Tacoma from 8 p.m. until 4 a.m. Tacoma officers will be joined by law enforcement from the Buckley Police Department, Lakewood Police Department, Orting Police Department, Puyallup Police Department and the Washington State Patrol in this ongoing effort to remove impaired drivers from the roadway.

Statewide, Target Zero Teams continue to strive for the ultimate goal of zero preventable fatalities by the year 2030. This year alone, the Tacoma Police Department has responded to 21 fatality collisions.

The Tacoma Police Department would like to remind those celebrating and drinking this holiday season to make a plan for a sober driver ahead of time, so everyone can get home safely. There is no excuse for impaired driving.
