### **Residential Burglary Arrest x 2**

Tacoma, Wash. – On February 10, at 9:39 a.m. South Sound 911 received a call from a female inside of a residence in the 1600 block of S. 54<sup>th</sup> St. reporting that someone had broken into her home and she was barricaded with her children in a bedroom. When officers arrived at 9:45 a.m. the suspect had fled.

While officers were getting suspect information from the victim's video surveillance system, South Sound 911 put out another burglary in progress at a residence in the 5400 block of S. Asotin St. The suspect description matched that of the suspect in the first residential burglary.

Containment was set up and officers located the suspect shortly after 10:00 a.m. in the 1400 block of S. 56<sup>th</sup> St. The suspect was taken into custody without incident.

The 41-year-old male suspect was booked into the Pierce County Jail for two counts of Residential Burglary.
