
Illegal Marijuana Operation

- > RCW 46.61.748 (Effective Jan.1, 2024)
- Operator has previously had vehicle impounded due to illegal racing conduct, <u>AND</u> operators is convicted of a subsequent offense originally charged as Reckless Driving or Racing.
- Vehicle is subject to forfeiture <u>after conviction</u> and operator used such vehicle to commit said crime.

Kia / Hyundai Task Force

In November of 2022, the Tacoma Police Department designated several investigators to focus on the rising Kia/Hyundai thefts and the associated crime. One detective is regularly working on these cases full time.

Some of these cases involved multiple suspects who committed violent felonies across multiple jurisdictions.

Total Overtime Hours: 255






Kia / Hyundai Task Force

Tacoma Police Detectives have been working closely with our Crime Analysis Unit (CAU) and our partners at South Sound 911 (SS911) to be able to identify the people involved in this network of criminal activity.
