Prolific Street Racing Organizer Arrested in Multi-Agency Operation

Tacoma, Wash. – On July 21, 2022, members of the Tacoma Police Department, Kent Police Department, Algona Police Department, and the Washington State Patrol conducted a joint arrest operation of a suspect believed to be responsible for organizing multiple street racing events throughout Pierce and King Counties.

The Kent Police Department had developed probable cause to arrest the 19-year-old male suspect for 13 charges including Aiding and Abetting Vehicular Assault, 3 counts of Reckless Driving, 3 counts of Reckless Endangerment, 2 counts of Disorderly Conduct, 3 counts of Unlawful Race Attendance, and Malicious Mischief 3.

The male was arrested just after 9 p.m. at a residence in Algona.

The male was booked into the King County Jail.

Charges related to street racing events the male is suspected of organizing in Tacoma will be filed through Tacoma Municipal Court.
