### **Homicide Investigation / Assault 1 Arrest**

Tacoma, Wash. –On June 26, at 10:35 p.m., South Sound 911 received a call stating multiple people had been shot at a residence in the 900 block of E. 52. St. An additional caller reported that there were two shooting suspects and one was still on scene.

Officers arrived and a male walked out of the house and collapsed. As officers were attempting to assess his injuries the 34-year-old male became combative. The male was detained and transported to a local hospital with serious injuries.

Officers located an unresponsive male in the backyard on the ground. The 38-year-old male was declared deceased on scene by Tacoma Fire Department personnel.

The deceased male resided at the house along with his wife, a 35-year-old female. Officers located the female outside of the residence with gunshot wounds. She was transported to a local hospital by ambulance with non-life-threatening injuries.

An adult female and three children inside the residence were not injured.

A 28-year-old male who had been shot at the residence was transported from the scene by private vehicle. The driver pulled over at E. 48 and Portland Avenue and called 911. The male was transported to a local hospital by ambulance from that location with non-life-threatening injuries

A 32-year-old male who had been shot at the residence left the scene and went to a Lakewood hospital for treatment of his gunshot wounds. Officers contacted and detained him at that location. After the male was released from the hospital he was booked into the Pierce County Jail on two counts of Assault 1.

Detectives and crime scene technicians are on scene.

The investigation is ongoing.
