Homicide Arrest

Tacoma, Wash. – On March 29, 2022, just after 9:00 p.m., officers responded to a shooting in the 4800 block of S. Sheridan Avenue. A vehicle was reported to have left the scene with a passenger who had been shot. The passenger was dropped off at a local hospital a few minutes later with life-threatening injuries.

The victim succumbed to his injuries at the hospital on April 13.

The Pierce County Medical Examiner's Office identified the victim as Marcus Patton, a 42-year-old male.

Detectives and forensic staff identified a suspect in this homicide and probable cause was developed for his arrest.

Today, at 10:02 a.m., officers took the 26-year-old male suspect into custody for the murder of Marcus Patton. The suspect was booked into jail for Murder 2 and Unlawful Possession of a Firearm 1.
