## Suspect in Repeated Vandalism to Eastside Home Arrested

Tacoma, Wash. – On May 25, 2022, officers contacted a resident in the 100 block of E. 68<sup>th</sup> St. regarding an adult male who had broken out windows at her residence. Officers had taken prior reports of the same suspect damaging the victim's fence and throwing a dead animal into her yard in the previous two weeks.

The resident had only recently moved into the neighborhood and had no idea why she was being targeted by the suspect.

The victim was able to provide officers with video footage of the destruction of her property. The victim also shared the video with local media.

Community members who saw the video footage were able to identify the suspect, and passed that information on to law enforcement.

Detectives established probable cause for the suspect's arrest.

Today at 3:39 p.m., officers arrested the 45-year-old male suspect at a residence in Tacoma.

The suspect was booked into jail for two counts of Malicious Mischief 2.
