Suspected Street Racing Organizers Face 26 Charges in Tacoma Municipal Court

Tacoma, Wash. – Four suspected street racing organizers have recently been charged with a total of 26 counts of Aiding and Abetting Reckless Driving in Tacoma Municipal Court. The four males had been arrested over the summer in multi-agency operations that included the Kent Police Department, Washington State Patrol, Lakewood Police Department, Pierce County Sheriff's Department, Ruston Police Department, and the United States Army Criminal Investigation Division.

Tacoma detectives submitted thirteen cases documenting the illegal street racing and intersection take over events occurring within the City of Tacoma from mid-January through March 2022.

The male suspects who were charged range from 18 -20 years of age.

Street racing is an unsanctioned and illegal form of auto racing that occurs on public streets and in public and/or private parking lots. The Tacoma Police Department is committed to addressing street racing through prevention and enforcement action.
