Shots Fired Calls Lead to Arrests / Search Warrant

Tacoma, Wash. – On September 10, 2022, at 2:37 a.m., multiple people called South Sound 911 to report hearing shots fired near the playground of an apartment complex in the 900 block of N. Pearl St. Officers responded and were able to get a description of the shooter and the vehicle the suspects had fled in.

Officers located and stopped the involved vehicle in the 600 block of N. Pearl St. A 41-year-old male and a 23-year-old male were arrested and booked into jail for Unlawful Possession of a Firearm and Unlawful Discharge of a Firearm within City limits. The vehicle was impounded for a search warrant.

Officers applied and were granted a search warrant for the vehicle. During the execution of the warrant officers recovered three handguns, spare magazines to include a loaded 50 round drum magazine, and eleven individually packaged bags of suspected crack cocaine.
