Tacoma Police Investigate Shooting at Residence

At approximately 7:00 a.m., members of the Tacoma Police Department responded to a suspected domestic dispute at a residence in the 1100 block of East 35th Street. Upon arrival it was learned that an armed, adult male subject unlawfully entered the home and was actively preventing two other adults from leaving. After attempts to de-escalate the situation were unsuccessful, the Tacoma Police Special Weapons and Tactics Team responded to the location.

During negotiations, one of the adults was released from the residence. A short time later gunshots were heard from inside the residence. SWAT entered the residence and found an adult female with multiple gunshot wounds and an adult male with a single gunshot wound. Both were transported to area hospitals.

No shots were fired by members of law enforcement during the event.

Detectives and Crime Scene Technicians have responded to the scene. The incident is being investigated as an Unlawful Imprisonment and Aggravated Assault investigation.

The investigation is on-going.
