## **Tacoma Police Seeks the Assistance of the Public in Solving Serial Arson Spree**

Tacoma, Wash. - On Sunday, July 14, 2024, at approximately 1:30 a.m., Tacoma Police and Tacoma Fire responded to a structure fire in the 1100 block of Dock Street. The fire resulted in a total loss to the structure. Hours later, three more fires were set along Puyallup Avenue, followed by two additional fires in Fife, WA. All incidents are believed to be connected, with no reported loss of life.

The Tacoma Police Arson Unit asks for the public's assistance. They urge community members and business owners in the neighborhoods surrounding the fires to review footage of their surveillance systems for suspicious activity. Anyone with information that may lead to the identification of the person or persons responsible for the fires is asked to contact Tacoma Police or leave a tip with Crime Stoppers using the P3tips app or by calling 1-800-222-TIPS.
