
E-Bike Rebate

Pilot Program

The Washington State Department of Transportation & City of Tacoma are both launching e-bike rebate programs this spring!

Apply between April 9 - April 23



Who can apply?

- Age 16+
- Reside in Washington State
- Provide contact information including an email

How much is the rebate for?

\$300 or \$1,200 off of a new e-bike purchase

If your annual household income is <u>equal to or lower</u> than the totals below- you qualify for a \$1,200 instant rebate. Everyone else qualifies for a \$300 instant rebate.

A household is a group of people who file taxes together. Income guidelines vary by county - if you live outside of Tacoma/Pierce County, visit the state e-bike website for more details.

Application Process

April 9 - April 23 at 12 pm, 2025: Application Open

WSDOT WE-Bike Instant Rebate Drawing

If selected in the statewide drawing - you'll receive an email and have 96 hours to provide residency information and, if applicable, income verification.

City of Tacoma E-Bike Rebate Drawing

If you were not selected in the WSDOT drawing and you are a Tacoma resident living in an overburdened community highly impacted by air quality - you'll be automatically entered into the City of Tacoma e-bike rebate drawing. If selected, you'll receive an email and have 96 hours to provide residency information and, if applicable, income verification.

Purchase a new e-bike at a partnering bike shop

Once your documents are approved, you'll receive your voucher via email. You will have 45 days, or until June 30th (whichever comes first), to purchase a qualifying e-bike at a participating bike shop.

Frequently Asked Questions

Will I need to pay for the bike up-front and get reimbursed?

No - these are instant rebates. If you receive one - the amount of your rebate (\$300 or \$1,200) will be taken off the total purchase price when you buy a new e-bike that meets program requirements at an approved bike shop.

I'm new to riding bikes - should I apply?

If you're interested in riding an e-bike, absolutely! The City of Tacoma will be offering free events and classes to help support new riders.

Am I guaranteed an e-bike if I apply?

No - the number of rebates are limited and not everyone who applies will get one.

Can multiple people in my household apply?

Yes - a maximum of one rebate per household will be awarded, but multiple people in your household can apply.
