6	of the Commencement Bay harbor area from Washington State Department of	
7	Natural Resources ("DNR") since March 1, 1980, and	
8	WHEREAS TFD is requesting authorization to execute a renewal of the	
9	Aquatic Lands Lease for an additional 12-year term to allow for the continued use of	
10 11	the Marine Security Operations Center ("MSOC") facility, and

ORDINANCE NO. 28971

1 2	AN ORDINANCE relating to the Six-Year Comprehensive Transportation Program; adopting the Six-Year Comprehensive Transportation Improvement Program amended for the years 2024 and 2025-2030.
3	WHEREAS RCW 35.77.010 provides that the legislative body of each
4 5	city and town shall: (1) prepare and adopt a comprehensive transportation
6	program for the ensuing six calendar years and annually thereafter, pursuant to
7	one or more public hearings; (2) prepare and adopt a revised and extended
8	comprehensive transportation program; and (3) file with the Secretary of
9 10	Transportation of the State of Washington each one-year extension and
11	revision thereof, and
12	WHEREAS RCW 35.77.010 further provides that each city shall include in
13	its comprehensive transportation program the intended expenditure of revenues for
14	non-motorized transportation purposes, and
15	WHEREAS the City adopted the Transportation Master Plan ("TMP") in
16 17	December 2015, with amendments adopted in June 2018, which included a
18	prioritized list of transportation projects, and
19	WHEREAS adoption of the TMP included extensive Citywide community
20	outreach, including attendance at neighborhood festivals and cleanups and two
21	public hearings, and
22	WHEREAS the proposed list of projects to be added to the Six-Year
23	Comprehensive Transportation Improvement Program ("Program") supports the
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25 26	goals, policies, and network priorities outlined in the TMP, and
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	WHEREAS the proposed Program was presented to the Transportation	
1	Commission on February 21 and March 20, 2024, and	
2	WHEREAS the proposed Program was presented to the Infrastructure,	
3 4	Planning, and Sustainability Committee on February 14 and March 27, 2024, and	
5	WHEREAS a presentation was also provided to the City Council at the May	
6	7, 2024, Study Session, and on May 21, 2024, a public hearing was held by the	
7	City Council to receive comments from members of the public on the proposed	
8	Program; Now, Therefore,	
9	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF TACOMA:	
10 11	Section 1. That the City Council has considered the testimony presented	
12	at the May 21, 2024, public hearing on the Six-Year Comprehensive	
13	Transportation Improvement Program amended for the years 2024 and 2025-	
14	2030.	
15	Section 2. That the Six-Year Comprehensive Transportation Improvement	
16 17	Program amended for the years 2024 and 2025-2030 is hereby adopted, said	
18	document to be substantially in the form of the proposed document on file in the	
19	office of the City Clerk.	
20	Section 3. That the City Clerk, in consultation with the City Attorney, is	
21	authorized to make necessary corrections to this ordinance, including, but not	
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1	limited to, the correction of scrivener's/clerical errors, references, ordinance		
2	numbering, section/subsection numbers, and any references thereto.
