

TIDY-UP Tacoma 2021

As community members venture out in support of local business districts, the City of Tacoma wants these areas to be as inviting as possible to reflect the resilience these businesses have exhibited over the last year and a half through COVID-19 restrictions. To accomplish this, Mayor Victoria Woodards and City Council have initiated Tidy-Up Tacoma 2021. Starting in September and running through November, City crews will be out on the main arterials of Neighborhood Business Districts to clean up litter/debris, perform graffiti removal, right-of-way landscaping, street sweeping, and more.

The Stadium and Hilltop Neighborhood Business Districts are currently under the Sound Transit project alignment for the Hilltop Tacoma Link Extension.

To keep work on schedule and without interruption, Sound Transit will be working with their contractor to clean up around their construction sites, in particular, remove any graffiti on construction signs and equipment.

The City will also provide litter and graffiti removal.
