1 A RESOLUTION relating to community and economic development; authorizing the acceptance of a grant and any associated term extensions with the 2 Washington State Department of Commerce, in the amount of \$4,000,000, and accepting and depositing said sum into the Revolving 3 Loan Fund, for Community Reinvestment Project loans and grants to stabilize, grow, and prevent displacement; and authorizing a subrecipient 4 agreement with the Tacoma Community Redevelopment Authority. 5 WHEREAS the City has applied for, and was awarded the Community 6 7 Reinvestment Project Grant ("Grant"), in the amount of \$4,000,000, from the 8 Washington State Department of Commerce, designed to address systemic 9 barriers related access to capital and the disproportionate impact of the Nixon-10 era War on Drugs on the Black, Latino, and Indigenous communities, and 11 WHEREAS the Grant will be implemented through a comprehensive 12 13 approach that includes both loans and grants, designed to meet the diverse 14 needs of Black, Latino, and Indigenous businesses, and 15 WHEREAS the Tacoma Community Redevelopment Authority has been 16 designated as the subrecipient of the \$2,900,000 loans portion of the Grant, 17 and its programs are designed to support businesses that are unable to access 18 19 traditional financing due to lack of collateral or credit history, and 20 WHEREAS the remaining \$1,100,000 of the grant will be managed by 21 the City, focusing on commercial rent and fixed asset grants, as well as 22 technical assistance support for businesses and administrative support/tools; 23 Now, Therefore, 24 25 26 -1-
