# SUBSTITUTE ORDINANCE NO. 28997

1	AN ORDINANCE relating to wastewater and surface water management;									
2	amending the Official Schedule of Stormwater and Wastewater Utility Service Rates and Fees, effective January 1, 2025, and January 1,									
3	2026; and amending Chapter 12.08B of the Municipal Code, relating to Use of Sanitary Sewer, by amending Section 12.08B.210, entitled									
4	"Rates and fees for wastewater service inside the City limits" to clarify									
5	the fees charged for the availability of wastewater service.									
6	WHEREAS the Environmental Services Department, working with the									
7	Environmental Services Commission, has updated its multi-year rate plan and									
8	developed proposed general revenue increases for the 2025-2026 Biennium for									
9	Wastewater and Stormwater customers, and									
10 11	WHEREAS the proposed rate increases are driven by the lower than									
12	planned implemented rate increases in 2021 and 2022 to provide some bill									
13	relief to customers during the Covid 19 pandemic, as well as ongoing operating									
14	expenses and construction inflation, and									
15	WHEREAS the proposed overall revenue increases are seven percent									
16 17	for Wastewater and eight percent for Stormwater, which also includes									
18	increased financial assistance for income-qualifying residential customers, and									
19	WHEREAS the guiding strategy for these rate adjustments is to maintain									
20	the lowest responsible cost increase for customers, while maintaining long-term									
21	financial sustainability of the utilities, and

23	WHEREAS the proper operation and adequate funding of the									
24	Wastewater and Stormwater utilities produces direct benefits in cleaner water									
25	discharges to Commencement Bay, and

	WHEREAS the utilities provide infrastructure and services to manage
1	wastewater and stormwater for the protection of health, property, and quality of
2	life for all residents; promote the growth and development of a vibrant
3 4	economy; and help sustain a healthy environment, and
5	WHEREAS the utility service rate and fee changes for 2025 and 2026 would
6	become effective January 1 of each year, and
7	WHEREAS consistent with state law, the City charges certain wastewater
8	fees or penalties when a customer is required to connect to an available public
9 10	sanitary sewer main as defined in the City's Side Sewer and Sanitary Sewer
10	Availability Manual, but the customer does not connect, and
12	WHEREAS the Environmental Services Department recommends amending
13	Section 12.08B.210 to clarify the fees charged for the availability of wastewater
14	service; Now, Therefore,
15	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF TACOMA:
16 17	Section 1. That the City Council hereby adopts the Recitals of this
18	Ordinance as its formal legislative findings.
19	Section 2. That the Official Schedule of Stormwater and Wastewater
20	Utility Service Rates and Fees, is hereby amended, effective January 1, 2025,
21	and January 1, 2026, as set forth in the attached Exhibits "A" for Wastewater
22 23	and "B" for Stormwater, respectively.
24	Section 3. That Chapter 12.08B of the Municipal Code, relating to Use of
25	Sanitary Sewer, is hereby amended, by amending Section 12.0B.210, entitled
26	"Rates and fees for wastewater service inside the City limits", to clarify the


