# To local resident or business owner:

This notice is to inform you of a pending application for a Special Event Permit which will impact roads and/or other public right-of-way in your neighborhood. Closing the road during this event is required for the greatest public safety. Efforts will be made to minimize the impact to your residence or business. Event coordinators are required to instruct participants to follow all applicable City, State and Federal laws. Access to private driveways, parking lots/garages, sidewalks, walkways and/or alley ways may be delayed during the event; emergency vehicles will always have access to roads. This letter has been mailed to the general surrounding area as part of our public notification process. Please feel free to share with others in your neighborhood.

### ROAD CLOSURE IMPACTS AND EVENT INFORMATION

The annual St. Paddy's Day Run will take place on Saturday, March 17, 2018 and involves road closures on Pacific Ave, north of South 8th St., Schuster Parkway, and Ruston Way—all will have full or partial closures. Closures will begin as early as 3:00 AM and will reopen at approximately 12 PM, or earlier. Marked detours will be in place. Temporary "No Parking" signs will be posted alongside the streets announcing the dates and times that no parking will be enforced. Vehicles must be moved by the time indicated or drivers will receive a citation and their vehicle may be towed and impounded. For details, see the diagram on the back of this notice.
